

GOVERNMENT NOTICE NO. 51

TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE DEVELOPMENT LOANS ACT, 1964

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS it is *inter alia* provided by subsection (1) of section 3 of the Development Loans Act, 1964, that for the purpose of financing general development in Trinidad and Tobago, the Government is authorised from time to time to borrow money externally or internally in a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate thirty million dollars in currency of the United States of America or the equivalent thereto :

And whereas it is further provided by the said subsection that the Government may borrow such further sum in such currency as may from time to time be specified by resolution passed by the Senate and the House of Representatives :

Be it resolved :

That for the purpose of financing general development in Trinidad and Tobago, the Government is hereby authorised from time to time to borrow money externally or internally in a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate fifteen million dollars in currency of the United States of America or the equivalent thereto.
