CHAPTER 285.

DIVISION OF TRINIDAD.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DIVISION OF THE ISLAND OF TRINIDAD. Ordinance No. 1 of 1918.

[1st January, 1919.]

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Division of Trinidad Ordinance. Short title.

2. The Island of Trinidad shall be divided into eight Counties, which shall bear the names and shall comprise the areas and be situated within the boundaries following, that is to say:— Division into Counties.

(I) THE COUNTY OF ST. GEORGE comprising the Islands of the Bocas, the Island of Patos or Goose Island, the Islands of Gaspar Grande, Gasparillo, Carrera, and Cronstadt and the Five Islands and all such parts of Trinidad as are bounded:—

On the east by a line drawn along the crest of the ridge forming the watershed eastward of the Madamas River to the main ridge of the Northern Range, thence by a line drawn in a westerly direction along the crest of the main ridge of the Northern Range to Aripo Trigonometrical Station No. 86, thence by a line drawn along the crest of the ridge forming the watershed between the Quare and Aripo Rivers to the Palmar Trigonometrical Station No. 87, thence by a line due west to the Aripo River and by the Aripo River to its junction with the Caroni River;

On the south by the Caroni River from its junction with the Aripo River to the St. Helena bridge, thence in a southerly direction by the Golden Grove Road to its junction with the Caroni Left Bank Road, thence in a westerly direction along

the southern side of the Caroni Left Bank Road to its junction with the Southern Main Road, thence along the southern side of the Southern Main Road to the eastern boundary of the Caroni Constabulary Station, thence along the eastern, southern, and western boundaries of the Caroni Constabulary Station to the southern side of the Southern Main Road, thence along the southern side of the Southern Main Road to the Caroni bridge, and thence by the Caroni River to the sea;

On the west and north by the sea.

(II) THE COUNTY OF ST. DAVID comprising all such parts of Trinidad as are bounded:—

On the west by the County of St. George;

On the south by a line drawn from the point where the Madamas eastern watershed meets the northern main ridge in an easterly direction along the crest of the main ridge of the Northern Range and along the crest of the spur of the said Range on which Palmiste Trigonometrical Station No. 419 is situated to the sea;

On the east and north by the sea.

(III) THE COUNTY OF CARONI comprising all such parts of Trinidad as are bounded:—

On the north by the southern boundary of the County of St. George from the mouth of the Caroni River to its junction with the Cumuto River;

On the east by the Cumuto River from its junction with the Caroni River to the point where it crosses the northern boundary of the Arena Reserve, thence by the northern, eastern, and southern boundaries of this reserve to Survey Station P4, thence by a line due south to the northern boundary of the Tumpuna Fuel Reserve, thence by the northern and eastern boundaries of this Reserve to the junction of the Tamana and Cumuto Roads, thence by the Cumuto Road to its intersection with the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve, thence in a westerly direction by such northern boundary, and thence by the western boundary of the said reserve to Survey Station I;

On the south by a line drawn from the last mentioned point in a westerly direction to Arenal Piparo Trigonometrical Station No. 83, thence by a line in a westerly direction to El Carmen Trigonometrical Station No. 428, thence by a line in a westerly direction to the Mayo Road and thence by the southern side of the Mayo and Cedar Hill Roads to the sea;

On the west by the sea.

(IV) THE COUNTY OF ST. ANDREW comprising all such parts of Trinidad as are bounded:—

On the north by the Counties of St. David and St. George;

On the west by the eastern boundary of the County of St. George and the eastern boundary of the County of Caroni to the place where the Cumuto Road touches the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve;

On the south by the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve from the last mentioned place in an easterly direction to the crest of the ridge that connects Mount Tamana to the crest of the main ridge of the Central Range, thence by a line drawn along the crest of this ridge in a southerly direction to its point of junction with the crest of the main ridge of the Central Range at or near the 12½ mile post on the Brasso Tamana Road; thence by a line drawn along the crest of the main ridge of the Central Range in an easterly direction to the source of the North Nariva River, and thence by the North Nariva River to the sea;

On the east by the sea.

(V) THE COUNTY OF VICTORIA comprising all such parts of Trinidad as are bounded:—

On the north by the County of Caroni;

On the east by the western boundary of the Central Range Reserve from Survey Station I to Survey Station D, thence by a line due south till it meets the Poole River, thence by the Poole River to a point on the said Poole River due north of the north-eastern corner of Cat's Hill Reserve at boundary pillar No. 2, thence by a line due south

to the said boundary pillar, thence by the eastern boundary of Cat's Hill Reserve to the south-eastern corner at boundary pillar No. 3, thence by a line drawn in a south-easterly direction to the north-western corner of Trinity Hills Reserve at boundary pillar No. 1, thence by the western boundary of Trinity Hills Reserve to the south-western corner at boundary pillar No. 7, and thence by a line drawn due south to the sea;

On the south by the sea;

On the west by a line drawn due north from the mouth of the Grande Rivière River to its point of intersection with a line drawn due east from the bridge on the San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road over the Godineau River, thence by the last mentioned line to the aforesaid bridge and thence by the Godineau River to the sea and by the sea.

(VI) THE COUNTY OF NARIVA comprising all such parts of Trinidad as are bounded:—

On the north by the Counties of St. Andrew and Caroni;

On the west by the County of Caroni and by the eastern boundary of the County of Victoria to the bridge where the Brothers' Settlement Road crosses the Poole River;

On the south by the Poole River from the above mentioned bridge to its junction with the Ortoire River, and thence by the Ortoire River to its mouth;

On the east by the sea.

(VII) THE COUNTY OF ST. PATRICK comprising all such parts of Trinidad as are bounded:—

On the north by the sea and the County of Victoria;

On the east by the County of Victoria;

On the south and west by the sea.

Included in this County is Soldier's Rock Island.

(VIII) THE COUNTY OF MAYARO comprising all such parts of Trinidad as are bounded:—

On the north by the County of Nariva;

On the west by the County of Victoria;

On the south and east by the sea.

3. The Counties in the last preceding section defined shall be divided into Wards as in the next eight succeeding sections provided. Division of
Counties into
Wards.

4. THE COUNTY OF ST. GEORGE shall be divided into five Wards, which shall bear the names, comprise the areas, and be situated within the boundaries following, that is to say:— County of
St. George.

- (1) *Diego Martin Ward* comprising the Islands of the Bocas, the Island of Pato's or Goose Island, the Islands of Gasper Grande, Gasparillo, Carrera, Cronstadt, and the Five Islands, and also such parts of the County of St. George as are bounded—

On the north by the sea;

On the east by a line beginning from La Vache Bay on the north coast and running south to the most northerly point of the western boundary of lands of R. D. Adam (15 acres), thence along the western boundary of this parcel of land and continuing south to the main ridge of the Northern Range, thence by a line along the crest of the main ridge of the Northern Range till it meets the ridge forming the watershed between the Santa Cruz and Maraval valleys, thence by a line along the crest of the ridge forming the eastern watershed of the Maraval valley to the northern boundary of Port-of-Spain at the junction of the Maraval and Circular Roads, and thence by the northern and western boundaries of Port-of-Spain to the sea;

On the south by the sea, and by the City of Port-of-Spain;

On the west by the sea.

- (2) *St. Ann's Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. George as are bounded:—

On the north by the sea;

On the east by a line beginning from Maracas Bay running south along the eastern boundary of Maracas Bay Estate to the main ridge of the Northern Range, thence by a line along the crest of the main ridge of the Northern Range in a

westerly direction till it meets the lateral ridge running southwards and dividing the Santa Cruz and Maracas valleys, thence by a line along the crest of this ridge to the north-eastern corner of Champ Fleur Estate, thence by the eastern boundaries of Champ Fleur and La Vivier Estates to the St. Joseph River, and thence by the St. Joseph River to its junction with the Caroni River;

On the south by the Caroni River from its junction with the St. Joseph River to the sea;

On the west by the eastern boundary of the Diego Martin Ward to the northern boundary of Port-of-Spain, thence by the northern and eastern boundaries of Port-of-Spain to the sea, and by the sea.

- (3) *Blanchisseuse Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. George as are bounded:—

On the north by the sea;

On the east by a line drawn along the crest of the ridge forming the watershed eastwards of the Madamas River till it reaches the crest of the main ridge of the Northern Range;

On the south by a line along the crest of the main ridge of the Northern Range from the last mentioned point to its junction with the western boundary of this Ward defined below;

On the west by the eastern boundary line of the Maracas Bay Estate southwards from the sea till it reaches the crest of the main ridge of the Northern Range.

- (4) *Tacarigua Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. George as are bounded:—

On the north by the southern boundary of the Ward of Blanchisseuse;

On the east by a line drawn along the crest of the ridge running south from the main ridge of the Northern Range through Trigonometrical Station Guacharo No. 170 to its junction with the Arima-Blanchisseuse Road near the 10th mile,

thence along a road reserve running in a southerly direction for 700 feet, thence along the crest of the ridge through Trigonometrical Stations El Padre No. 168, Cangrejal No. 8, and La Ressource No. 255, till it meets the Arouca River, thence by the Arouca River to the Eastern Main Road, thence eastwards by the Eastern Main Road to its junction with the Mausica Road, thence by the Mausica Road to its junction with the Caroni North Bank Road, thence by a line due south to the Caroni River; (*Substituted by Proclamation No. 77 of 1920.*)

On the south by the Caroni River from the point where the eastern boundary of the Ward touches the Caroni River to the St. Helena bridge, thence by the southern boundary of the County of St. George to the south-eastern corner of St. Ann's Ward;

On the west by the eastern boundary of St. Ann's Ward;

- (5) *Arima Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. George as are bounded:—

On the north by the southern boundary of the Ward of Blanchisseuse;

On the east by a line drawn from Aripo Trigonometrical Station No. 86, along the crest of the ridge forming the watershed between the Quare and Aripo Rivers to the Palmar Trigonometrical Station No. 87, thence by a line due west to the Aripo River and by the Aripo River to its junction with the Caroni River;

On the south by the Caroni River;

On the west by the eastern boundary of Tacarigua Ward.

5. THE COUNTY OF ST. DAVID shall form a single Ward, which shall bear the name of Toco Ward. County of St. David.

6. THE COUNTY OF CARONI shall be divided into five Wards, which shall bear the names, comprise the areas, County of Caroni.

and be situated within the boundaries following, that is to say:—

- (1) *Cunupia Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Caroni as are bounded:—

On the north by the northern boundary of the County of Caroni from the mouth of the Caroni River to its junction with the Arena River;

On the east by the Arena River from its junction with the Caroni River to its source, thence by a line due south to the Mahaica trace, thence by the Mahaica trace to its junction with the Quebrada Clara trace;

On the south by a line from the last mentioned point to the source of the Cunupia River, thence by the Cunupia River to where it crosses the Chin Chin Road, thence by the Chin Chin Road to its junction with the Southern Main Road, thence by the Southern Main Road to its junction with the Cunupia Station Road, thence by the Cunupia Station Road, the Alligator Road, and the Munro Road, and thence by a line running west to the sea;

On the west by the sea.

- (2) *Chaguanas Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Caroni as are bounded:—

On the north by the southern boundary of Cunupia Ward;

On the east by a line from the junction of the Mahaica and Quebrada Clara traces to the bridge where the La Gloria Road crosses the Talparo River, and thence by the Talparo River to where it crosses the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve;

On the south from the last mentioned point by the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve to where it crosses the Mamoral Road, thence by the Mamoral Road to its junction with the Caparo River Road, thence by the Caparo River Road to its junction with the Caparo Valley Road, thence by the Caparo Valley Road to a point due east of Mills Trigonometrical Station

No. 312, thence by a line through Mills Trigonometrical Station No. 312 to Arena Trigonometrical Station No. 319, thence by a line due south to the Arena Local Road, thence by the Arena Local Road to its junction with the La Cuesa Road, thence by the La Cuesa Road to its junction with the Freeport Mission Road, thence by the Freeport Mission Road to its junction with the Southern Main Road, thence by the Southern Main Road to its junction with the Waterloo Road, thence by the Waterloo Road to the point where it turns south to Couva, and thence by a line drawn in a westerly direction to the sea;

On the west by the sea.

- (3) *San Rafael Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Caroni as are bounded :—

On the north by the Caroni River from its junction with the Arena River to its junction with the Cumuto River.

On the east by the Cumuto River from the last mentioned point to where it crosses the northern boundary of the Arena Reserve, thence by the northern, eastern, and southern boundaries of this Reserve to Survey Station P4, thence by a line due south to the northern boundary of the Tumpuna Fuel Reserve, thence by the northern and eastern boundaries of this Reserve to the junction of the Tamana and Cumuto Roads, and thence by the Cumuto Road to its intersection with the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve;

On the south by the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve from the last mentioned point to where it crosses the Talparo River;

On the west by the eastern boundaries of Chaguanas and Cunupia Wards.

- (4) *Montserrat Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Caroni as are bounded :—

On the north by the southern boundary of the Chaguanas Ward;

On the east by the western boundary of the Central Range Reserve;

On the south by a line from Survey Station I of the Central Range Reserve in a westerly direction to the Arenal Piparo Trigonometrical Station No. 83, thence by a line in a westerly direction to El Carmen Trigonometrical Station No. 428, thence by a line in a westerly direction to the Mayo Road, thence by the southern side of the Mayo Road to the Cedar Hill Road, and thence by the southern side of the Cedar Hill Road to its junction with the Kanga Settlement Road;

On the west by the Kanga Settlement Road from the last mentioned point to its junction with the Indian Trail Road, thence by the Indian Trail Road to the Rivulet Road, thence by the Rivulet Road to its junction with the Milton Road, thence by the Milton Road to its junction with the Couva Main Road, thence by the Couva Main Road to its junction with the Calcutta Settlement Road No. 11, and thence by the Calcutta Settlement Road No. 11 and its extension to the southern boundary of the Chaguanas Ward.

- (5) *Couva Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Caroni as are bounded :—

On the north by the southern boundary of the Chaguanas Ward;

On the east by the western boundary of the Montserrat Ward;

On the south by the Cedar Hill Road;

On the west by the sea.

County of
St. Andrew.

7. THE COUNTY OF ST. ANDREW shall be divided into five Wards, which shall bear the names, comprise the areas, and be situated within the boundaries following, that is to say :—

- (1) *Valencia Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. Andrew as are bounded :—

On the north by a line along the crest of the main ridge of the Northern Range in an easterly direction from Aripo Trigonometrical Station No. 86 to where it is crossed by the Sangre Grande-Grande Rivière Road;

On the east by the Sangre Grande-Grande Rivière Road from the point where it crosses the crest of the main ridge of the Northern Range to its junction with the Toco Road, and thence by the Toco Road to the Melajo River;

On the south by the Toco Road from the last mentioned point to its junction with the Valencia Road, thence by the Valencia Road to its junction with the Eastern Main Road, and thence by the Eastern Main Road to the Aripo River;

On the west by the eastern boundary of Arima Ward.

- (2) *Matura Ward* comprising such parts of the County of St. Andrew as are bounded :—

On the north by a line along the crest of the main ridge of the Northern Range and by a line along the crest of the spur of the said Range on which Palmiste Trigonometrical Station No. 419 is situated which runs in a south-easterly direction till it reaches the sea;

On the east by the sea;

On the south by the Oropuche River from its mouth to its junction with the Melajo River, and thence by the Melajo River to the Toco Main Road;

On the west by the eastern boundary of Valencia Ward.

- (3) *Manzanilla Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. Andrew as are bounded :—

On the north by the southern boundary of Valencia Ward and by the southern boundary of Matura Ward;

On the east by the sea;

On the south by the sea;

On the west by the Eastern Main Road from the sea to its junction with the Guaico-Tamana Road, thence by the Guaico-Tamana Road to where it touches the southern boundary of the Trinidad Government Railway lands, thence in a westerly direction by such boundary to where it crosses the Cumuto Road, thence by the

Cumuto Road to where it crosses the Aripo River, and thence by the Aripo River to where it is crossed by the Eastern Main Road.

- (4) *Turure Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. Andrew as are bounded:—

On the north by the Eastern Main Road from its junction with the Guaico-Tamana Road to the sea;

On the east by the sea;

On the south by the North Nariva river from its mouth to its source on the main ridge of the Central Range, thence by a line along the crest of the main ridge of the Central Range to its junction with the ridge to Mount Tamana at or near the 12½ mile post on the Brasso-Tamana Road;

On the west by a line along the crest of the Tamana spur from the last mentioned point till it intersects the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve, thence in an easterly direction by the northern boundary of this reserve to the point where it crosses the Tamana-Biche Road, thence northwards by the Tamana-Biche Road to its junction with the Guaico-Tamana Road, and thence by the Guaico-Tamana Road till it meets the Eastern Main Road.

- (5) *Tamana Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. Andrew as are bounded:—

On the north by the Aripo River from its junction with the Cumuto River to where it is crossed by the Cumuto Road, thence by the Cumuto Road to where it touches the southern boundary of the Trinidad Government Railway lands, and thence by such boundary to its junction with the Guaico-Tamana Road;

On the east by the Guaico-Tamana Road from such last mentioned point to the Biche-Tamana Road, and thence by the Biche-Tamana Road to where it crosses the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve;

On the south by the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve from the last mentioned point to the Cumuto Road;

On the west by the eastern boundary of San Rafael Ward.

8. THE COUNTY OF VICTORIA shall be divided into five Wards, which shall bear the names, comprise the areas, and be situated within the boundaries following, that is to say:— County of Victoria.

(1) *Pointe-à-Pierre Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Victoria as are bounded:—

On the north by the southern boundaries of Couva and Montserrat Wards;

On the east by the western boundary of the Central Range Reserve;

On the south by a line drawn from Survey Station D at the south-western corner of the Central Range Reserve due south till it meets the Dindial trace, thence by the Dindial trace to its junction with the Pascual Road, thence by the Pascual Road to its junction with the Piparo Road, thence by the Piparo Road to the Guaracara River, and thence by the Guaracara River to the sea;

On the west by the sea.

(2) *Naparima Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Victoria as are bounded:—

On the north by the Guaracara River;

On the east by Allen Street from where it crosses the Guaracara River till it meets the Guaracara-Tabaquite Road, thence by the Guaracara-Tabaquite Road to Reform Road, thence by Reform Road to the Naparima-Mayaro Road, thence by the Naparima-Mayaro Road to the Malgretoute Road, thence by the Malgretoute Road to the Manahambre Road, thence by the Manahambre Road to the Woodford Dale trace, thence by the Woodford Dale trace to the Ciperio Road, thence by the Ciperio Road to its junction with the St. Croix Road, thence by the St. Croix Road to its junction with a reserved trace running southwards through the Lengua Settlement, thence by this trace to the Oropuche River, and thence by a line drawn due south to meet a line running due east from the bridge on the San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road over the Godineau River;

On the south by a line running due west from the last mentioned point to meet the bridge on the San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road crossing the Godineau River, and thence by the Godineau River to the sea;

On the west by the sea.

- (3) *Savana Grande Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Victoria as are bounded:—

On the north by the southern boundary of the Pointe-à-Pierre Ward;

On the east by a line from Survey Station D of the Central Range Reserve running due south to meet the Poole River, thence by the Poole River to the Brothers Settlement Road, thence by the Brothers Settlement Road and Torib trace to the Naparima-Mayaro Road, thence by the Naparima-Mayaro Road, to the Moruga Road, and thence by the Moruga Road till it meets the projection of a line drawn due east from the bridge on the San Fernando-Siparia-Erin Road over the Godineau River;

On the south by a line drawn west from the last mentioned point to meet the south-eastern corner of Naparima Ward;

On the west by the eastern boundary of the Naparima Ward.

- (4) *Ortoire Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Victoria as are bounded:—

On the north by the Poole River from where it is crossed by the Brothers Settlement Road to its intersection with a line drawn northwards from the north-eastern corner of Cats Hill Reserve;

On the east by a line running south from the last mentioned point to the north-eastern corner of Cats Hill Reserve, and thence by the eastern boundary of Cats Hill Reserve to the south-eastern corner thereof;

On the south by the southern boundary of Cats Hill Reserve to the south-western corner thereof, thence by the western boundary of Cats Hill Reserve to its point of intersection with a line drawn east from the south-eastern corner of

Savana Grande Ward, and thence westwards by the last mentioned line to the south-eastern corner of Savana Grande Ward;

On the west by the eastern boundary of Savana Grande Ward.

- (5) *Moruga Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Victoria as are bounded:—

On the west by a line drawn north from the mouth of the Grande Rivière River to the southern boundary of the Naparima Ward;

On the north by the southern boundaries of Naparima, Savana Grandé, and Ortoire Wards;

On the east by a line running in a south-easterly direction from the south-eastern corner of Cats Hill Reserve to the north-western corner of Trinity Hills Reserve at boundary pillar No. 1, thence south along the western boundary of Trinity Hills Reserve to the south-western corner thereof at boundary pillar No. 7, and thence by a line south to the sea;

On the south by the sea.

9. THE COUNTY OF NARIVA shall be divided into two Wards, which shall bear the names, comprise the areas, and be situated within the boundaries following, that is to say:—

Nariva.

- (1) *Charuma Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Nariva as are bounded:—

On the north by the northern boundary of the Central Range Reserve from its north-western corner at Survey Station 4a to the south-western corner of Tamana Ward, thence by the southern and western boundaries respectively of Tamana and Turure Wards, and thence by the southern boundary of Turure Ward to the point where the Cunapo Southern Road crosses the North Nariva River;

On the east by the Cunapo Southern Road from the last mentioned point to its junction with the Naparima-Mayaro Road, thence by the Naparima-Mayaro Road to its junction with the Guayaguayare Road, and thence by the Guayaguayare Road to the Poole River;

On the south from the last mentioned point by the Poole River till it meets a line drawn due south from Survey Station D of the Central Range Reserve;

On the west by a line drawn due north from the last mentioned point to Survey Station D of the Central Range Reserve, and thence by the western boundary of the Central Range Reserve to Survey Station 4a.

- (2) *Cocal Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of Nariva as are bounded:—

On the north by the southern boundary of the Turure Ward;

On the east by the sea;

On the south by the Ortoire River from its mouth to the Poole River, and thence by the Poole River till it meets the Guayaguayare Road;

On the west by the eastern boundary of Charuma Ward.

10. THE COUNTY OF ST. PATRICK shall be divided into four Wards, which shall bear the names, comprise the areas, and be situated within the boundaries following, that is to say:—

- (1) *Cedros Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. Patrick as are bounded:—

On the north by the sea;

On the east by the Erin Road from Cap-deville to the Puerto Grande Road, thence by the Puerto Grande Road to the La Ressource Road, and thence westwards by the La Ressource Road to the sea;

On the south by the sea;

On the west by the sea.

- (2) *La Brea Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. Patrick as are bounded:—

On the north by the sea;

On the east by the Silver Stream River from its mouth to a line due east of boundary pillar No. 17 of Morne L'Enfer Reserve, thence in a westerly direction by such line to the said boundary pillar No. 17, and thence by the eastern

boundary of the reserve to its intersection with the northern boundary of the Erin Reserve;

On the south by the northern boundary of the Erin Reserve from the last mentioned point in a westerly direction to boundary pillar No. 1, and thence by a line in direction west 18 degrees north to the eastern boundary of Cedros Ward;

On the west by the eastern boundary of Cedros Ward.

- (3) *Erin Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. Patrick as are bounded:—

On the north by the southern boundary of La Brea Ward, thence eastwards by the northern boundary of the Erin Reserve to boundary pillar No. 8, thence by the eastern boundary of the Erin Reserve to the crest of the main Southern Range, thence by a line along the crest of this range to the boundary of the Southern Watershed Reserve, and thence by the northern boundary of the Southern Watershed Reserve to the Peñal-Quinam Road;

On the east by the Peñal-Quinam Road from the last mentioned point to the sea;

On the south by the sea;

On the west by the Cedros Ward.

- (4) *Siparia Ward* comprising all such parts of the County of St. Patrick as are bounded:—

On the north by the sea and the southern boundary of Naparima Ward;

On the east by the western boundary of Moruga Ward;

On the south by the sea;

On the west by the La Brea and Erin Wards.

11. THE COUNTY OF MAYARO shall be divided into two Wards, which shall bear the names, comprise the areas, and be situated within the boundaries following, that is to say:—

- (1) *Gudyaguayare Ward* shall comprise all such parts of the County of Mayaro as are bounded:—

On the north by the southern boundary of the Cocal Ward;

On the east by the sea;
On the south by the sea;
On the west by the Guayaguayare Road from the sea to the Poole River.

(2) *Trinity Ward* shall comprise all such parts of the County of Mayaro as are bounded:—

On the north by the Poole River;
On the east by the Guayaguayare Road from the Poole River to the sea;
On the south by the sea;
On the west by the eastern boundaries of Moruga and Ortoire Wards.

Division of
Wards into
Quarters.

12. The Governor in Executive Council may, by proclamation, divide any Ward into divisions to be known as Quarters, and declare the name by which each such Quarter shall be known.

Islands not
specifically
mentioned.

13. Islands not specifically mentioned as being comprised within any County, Ward, or Quarter in this Ordinance, or in any proclamation made thereunder, shall be deemed for all purposes to be comprised within the County, Ward, or Quarter as the case may be, to the sea boundary of which they are nearest measured in a straight line.

Rivers, etc.,
as boundaries.

14. (1) Where, in or under the provisions of this Ordinance, a river, road, trace, or crest of a range or spur is made the boundary of any County, Ward, or Quarter, such boundary shall, subject to the express provisions of this Ordinance, be deemed to be a line drawn along the middle of such river, road, trace, or crest.

(2) The Governor may, by proclamation, direct that boundary posts shall be erected on any crest named in the proclamation, and thereupon the boundary shall be deemed to be a straight line drawn between such posts.

Change of
names,
boundaries,
etc., of Wards
and
Quarters.

15. The Governor in Executive Council may, by proclamation—

- (a) change the name of any Ward or Quarter;
- (b) alter the areas comprised within or the boundaries of any Ward or Quarter;

(c) divide any Ward or Quarter into two or more Wards or Quarters respectively, or amalgamate any two or more Wards or Quarters respectively.

16. All references in any Ordinance, and in every rule, regulation, or bye-law made and issued under the authority of any Ordinance, and in any Order in Council, proclamation, or order made under lawful authority, to any County, Ward, or Quarter in Trinidad by any name mentioned in this Ordinance or conferred under the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be to the particular County, Ward, or Quarter, as the case may be, defined in this Ordinance or in any proclamation issued under the provisions of this Ordinance.
