AN ORDINANCE to amend the Division of Trinidad
Ordinance, 1926.

[1st January, 1927.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Division of Short title. Trinidad (Amendment) Ordinance, 1927, and shall be Construction. read as one with the Division of Trinidad Ordinance, 1926, 5-1926. hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. The following shall be substituted for the description of the Southern boundary of the County of Caroni set out in paragraph (III) of section 2 of the Principal Ordinance :— Southern boundary of County of Caroni.

On the South by the western boundary of the Central Range Reserve from Survey Station I to a point due east of the south-eastern corner of a parcel of

land containing 200 acres granted to Edward F. Stone, thence by a line due west to the said corner of the said land, thence by the southern and western boundaries of the said land to the point where the Guanapure River crosses the said western boundary and thence by that branch of the said river which crosses the Guanapure Road immediately south of Cogollar Trigonometrical Station No. 43 to the Guanapure Road, thence by the Guanapure and San Coco Roads to the point where the latter leaves the watershed of the central range, thence by the watershed of the central range to the Mayo Road and thence by the southern sides of the Mayo and Cedar Hill Roads to the Southern Main Road and thence by a line due west to the sea.

Ordinance
retrospective.

3. This Ordinance shall operate retrospectively and shall be deemed to have commenced and come into operation on the first day of January, 1927.

Passed in Council this twenty-fifth day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.
