AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 3 (1) OF THE
AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE, 1950

1. This Order may be cited as the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Manufacture of Buttons, Buckles and Ornaments) Order, 1953.

2. The manufacture of buttons, buckles and ornaments is hereby declared to be a pioneer industry for the purposes of the Aid to Pioneer Industries Ordinance, 1950, and leather, cotton, plastic, wood and metal buttons, buckles and ornaments are hereby declared to be pioneer products for the said purposes.
