REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE AUTHORITY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER
UNDER SECTION 33 OF THE CIVIL AVIATION ACT AND SUBJECT TO
NEGATIVE RESOLUTION OF PARLIAMENT

THE CIVIL AVIATION [(NO. 3) AIR OPERATOR CERTIFICATION
AND ADMINISTRATION] (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2012

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation [(No. 3) Air Citation
Operator Certification and Administration] (Amendment) Regulations,
2012.
2. In these Regulations, “the Regulations” means the Civil Aviation Interpretation
[(No. 3) Air Operator Certification and Administration] Regulations, L.N. No. 102
2004, of 2004.
3. Regulation 2 of the Regulations is amended by inserting in the Regulation 2
appropriate alphabetical sequence the following definition: amended
“appropriate authority” means—
 - (a) in relation to flight over the high seas, the relevant
authority of the State of Registry; or
 - (b) in relation to flight other than over the high seas, the
relevant authority of the State having sovereignty
over the territory being overflown;”.
4. Regulation 37A of the Regulations is amended by inserting after Regulation 37A
subregulation (5), the following subregulations: amended
 - “ (6) An operator shall, as part of its safety management
system,—
 - (a) establish a flight safety documents system for the use
and guidance of operational personnel; and
 - (b) assess the level of rescue and firefighting service
(RFFS) protection available at an aerodrome
intended to be specified in the operational flight plan
in order to ensure an acceptable level of protection is
available for the aircraft intended to be used.

(7) An operator shall ensure that the operations manual contains information related to the level of rescue and fire-fighting service protection that he deems to be acceptable.”.
