REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE AUTHORITY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTER
UNDER SECTION 33 OF THE CIVIL AVIATION ACT

THE CIVIL AVIATION [(NO. 6) APPROVED MAINTENANCE
ORGANIZATION] (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2007

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation [(No. 6) Citation
Approved Maintenance Organization] (Amendment) Regulations, 2007.

2. In these Regulations, “the Regulations” means the Civil Aviation Interpretation
[(No. 6) Approved Maintenance Organization] Regulations, 2004. L.N. Nos. 49
and 105 of
2004

3. Regulation 2 of the regulations is amended by inserting after the Regulation 2
definition of “safety and quality policy” the following new definition: amended

“ “safety management system” means a systematic approach
to managing safety including the necessary
organizational structures, accountabilities, policies and
procedures;”.

4. The Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 6 the Regulation
following new regulation: 6A inserted

“Safety Management System

Safety
management
system 6A. (1) From 1st January, 2009, an Approved
Maintenance Organization shall implement a safety
management system acceptable to the Authority that —

- (a) identifies safety hazards;
- (b) ensures that remedial action necessary to
maintain the acceptable level of safety
established by the Director General under
subregulation (1) is implemented;
- (c) provides for continuous monitoring and
regular assessment of the safety level
achieved; and

(d) aims to make continuous improvement to the overall level of safety.

(2) The Director General shall establish an acceptable level of safety to be achieved in the maintenance of aircraft.

(3) As part of the safety management system required by subregulation (1), an Approved Maintenance Organization shall clearly define lines of safety accountability throughout its organization, including a direct accountability for safety on the part of senior management.”.
