REGULATIONS

MADE BY THE CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE
MINISTER UNDER SECTION 33 OF THE CIVIL AVIATION ACT

THE CIVIL AVIATION [(NO. 9) AVIATION TRAINING
ORGANIZATION] (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS,
2005

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation [(No. 9) Citation
Aviation Training Organization] (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations,
2005.

2. In these Regulations, “the Regulations” means the Civil Aviation Interpretation
[(No. 9) Aviation Training Organization] Regulations, 2004. L.N. No. 52 of
2004

3. Regulation 4 of the Regulations is amended— Regulation 4
amended

(a) in subregulation (1) by—

- (i) deleting the word “and” at the end of paragraph (a);
- (ii) inserting after paragraph (a), the following:

“(aa) holds a valid certificate for the training of airmen, issued by another Contracting State, which is accepted by the Authority under these Regulations and has been issued Training Specifications by the Authority”; and

(b) in subregulation (2)—

- (i) by deleting the word “or” at the end of paragraph (a);
- (ii) in paragraph (b), by deleting the word “Regulations.” and substituting the words “Regulations; and”; and

(iii) by inserting after paragraph (b), the following:

“(c) he holds a valid certificate for the training, testing or checking of airmen in an advanced training device or a flight simulator issued by another Contracting State which is accepted by the Authority under these Regulations and he has been issued Training Specifications by the Authority.”.

5A inserted

4. The Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 5 the following:

“Application
for training
specifications

5A. (1) A person who holds a valid training certificate for the training, testing or checking of airmen; issued by another Contracting State may apply to the Authority for the issue of Training Specifications.

(2) An application under subregulation (1), shall be accompanied by—

(a) the prescribed fee; and

(b) such documents as may be specified by the Authority.

6A inserted

5. The Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 6 the following:

“Issue of
Training
Specifications

6A. The DG may recommend the Authority issue Training Specifications to an applicant under regulation 5A where he is satisfied that the applicant meets the applicable requirements of these Regulations.”.

Regulation 61
amended

6. Regulation 61 of the Regulations is amended—

(a) in subregulation (1), by deleting the words “eighteen months from the date of publication of these Regulations” and substituting the words “on 1st July, 2006”; and

(b) in subregulation (2), by deleting the words “within the eighteen months period provided under subregulation (1)” and substituting the words “on or before 30th June, 2006.”.
