



TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 36 of 1966

[L.S.]

AN ACT to prescribe the salaries and allowances payable to the holders of certain offices, to provide for the retrospective payment of salaries and allowances to certain members of the Public Service Commission, to provide for the exercise of the powers vested in the Judicial and Legal Service Commission under section 84 of the Constitution, and to prescribe the retiring age of the Auditor General.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment}
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and

House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Prescribed Matters) Act, 1966.

Salaries and allowances of holders of certain offices

2. (1) There shall be paid to the holder of an office specified in the first column of the First Schedule a monthly salary at the rate specified in respect thereof in the second column of the said Schedule.

(2) There shall be paid to the holder of an office specified in the first column of the First Schedule such allowances as the Governor-General may by Order prescribe.

Sum payable to Chairman of Public Service Commission

3. There shall be paid to the Chairman of the Public Service Commission in respect of the period commencing on the first day of December, 1960, and ending on the day immediately preceding the date of the coming into operation of this Act a sum calculated at the rate of sixty dollars per month.

Sum payable to members of the Public Service Commission other than the Chairman, and Vice-Chairman

4. (1) There shall be paid to each member of the Public Service Commission other than the Chairman and the Deputy Chairman in respect of the period commencing on the 1st day of January, 1962, or in the case of a member appointed after that date, the date of his appointment, and ending on the day immediately preceding the date of the coming into operation of this Act a sum calculated at the rate of two hundred dollars per month.

(2) There shall be paid to a member of the Public Service Commission, other than the Chairman and the Deputy Chairman, who held office on the 1st day of January, 1962, but ceased to hold office prior to the coming into operation of this Act, in respect of the period commencing on the 1st day of January, 1962, and ending on the date on which he ceased to hold office, a sum calculated at the rate specified in subsection (1).

Payment of salaries and charged on the Consolidated Fund

5. The salaries and allowances prescribed in sections 2, 3 and 4 shall be a charge on the Consolidated Fund.

Offices subject to Judicial and Legal Service Commission

6. Section 84 of the Constitution applies to the offices in the public service specified in the Second Schedule.

7. The age at which the Auditor General is required to vacate his office under section 97 of the Constitution is sixty years. Retirement age of Auditor General

8. The Constitution (Prescribed Matters) Ordinance, 1960 is hereby repealed. Repeal of Ord. No. 26—1960
