MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE
AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES ORDINANCE

THE AID TO PIONEER INDUSTRIES (GENESCO LIMITED)
(MANUFACTURE AND ASSEMBLY OF REFRIGERATORS
AND WATER COOLERS) ORDER, 1965

1. This Order may be cited as the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Genesco Limited) (Manufacture and Assembly of Refrigerators and Water Coolers) Order, 1965.

2. Genesco Limited, a company registered under the Companies Ordinance, Ch. 31. No. 1 (hereinafter referred to as the "pioneer company") is hereby declared to be a pioneer manufacturer for the purposes of the Aid to Pioneer Industries Ordinance (hereinafter referred to as "the Ordinance") in relation to—

- (a) its pioneer factory located at No. 83-85 Edward Street, in the City of Port-of-Spain, and
- (b) the manufacture and assembly of refrigerators and water coolers mechanically or thermally operated, by the Aid to Pioneer Industries (Manufacture and Assembly of Refrigerators and Water Coolers) Order, 1959, declared to be a pioneer industry,

with effect from the 31st day of July, 1965 and the production day of the said factory is hereby declared to be the 30th day of October, 1965.

3. This Order is subject to the following continuing conditions:—

- (a) that the pioneer company shall keep its pioneer factory equipped with the following minimum items of machinery and equipment—
 - (i) one metal forming brake or bender,
 - (ii) two metal shears,
 - (iii) one metal punch,
 - (iv) complement of welding equipment,
 - (v) spray painting machine,
 - (vi) refrigeration tools,
 - (vii) refrigeration evacuating and charging equipment (minimum capacity of twenty (20) tons);
 - (ii) two metal shears,
 - (iii) one metal punch,
 - (iv) complement of welding equipment,
 - (v) spray painting machine,
 - (vi) refrigeration tools,
 - (vii) refrigeration evacuating and charging equipment (minimum capacity of twenty (20) tons);
- (b) that the pioneer company shall maintain accounts in respect of the pioneer enterprise to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Income Tax;
- (c) that the pioneer company shall—
 - (i) observe the practice and policy generally accepted in Trinidad and Tobago with respect to labour relations and conditions of employment,

- (ii) as far as practicable, recruit its employees through the Employment Exchange of the Ministry of Labour;
- (d) that, notwithstanding the exemption from income tax under section 8 of the Ordinance the pioneer company shall submit annually a return of the income so exempt from tax at the same time and in the same manner as it would be required to do if the income were not exempt from tax.
