REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 3 of 1977**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the promotion of Nellie Warner,  
former Caretaker, Ministry for Tobago Affairs and  
for the payment of superannuation benefits to the  
said Nellie Warner.

*[Assented to 24th February, 1977]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as **Enactment**  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions (Nellie Short title  
Warner) Act, 1977.

Appointment  
on promotion  
and authority to  
pay gratuity and  
reduced pension

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary—

- (a) Nellie Warner, former Caretaker, Ministry for Tobago Affairs shall be deemed to have been appointed on promotion to the post of Rest House Keeper, Ministry for Tobago Affairs, with effect from the 1st January, 1972 and to have retired from the public service as Rest House Keeper, Ministry for Tobago Affairs, on her attaining the age of sixty years on the 27th October, 1975;
- (b) there shall be paid from the Consolidated Fund to the said Nellie Warner a gratuity of five thousand, seven hundred and eight dollars and twenty-five cents and a reduced pension payable monthly at the rate of one thousand, three hundred and sixty-nine dollars and ninety-eight cents per annum with effect from the 27th October, 1975.
