REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 19 of 1977**

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the promotion of Olive Jones former Caretaker, Ministry for Tobago Affairs and for the payment of Superannuation benefits to the said Olive Jones.

*[Assented to 3rd May, 1977]*

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Olive Jones (Promotion Short title and Superannuation Benefits) Act, 1977.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary:—

- (a) Olive Jones, former Caretaker, Ministry for Tobago Affairs shall be deemed to have been appointed on promotion to the post of Rest House Keeper, Ministry for Tobago Affairs, with effect from the 1st day of January, 1972 and to have retired from the Public Service as Rest House Keeper with effect from the 29th day of November, 1973;
- (b) there shall be paid from the Consolidated Fund to the said Olive Jones a gratuity of five thousand and twelve dollars and fifty-six cents and a reduced pension, payable monthly, with effect from the 29th day of November, 1973 at the rate of one thousand two hundred and three dollars and two cents per annum.
