Act No. 53 of 1975

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of Sydney Smith as Clerk I, Ministry of Agriculture, Lands and Fisheries and for the payment of superannuation benefits to the said Sydney Smith.

[Assented to 1st December, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Sydney Smith (Pension ^{Short title} and Gratuity) Act, 1975.

2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary there shall be paid from the Consolidated Fund to Sydney Smith who shall be deemed to be appointed Clerk I in the Ministry of Agriculture, Lands and Fisheries with effect from 26th April, 1966, a gratuity of two thousand nine hundred and sixteen dollars and a reduced pension payable monthly at the rate of six hundred and ninety-nine dollars and eighty cents per annum with effect from 20th May, 1970, the date on which he attained the compulsory retirement age of sixty years.
