TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO
Act No. 60 of 1975

AN ACT to provide for the retirement of Carlton Comma, Secretary/Librarian of the Public Library of Trinidad and for the payment of superannuation benefits to the said Carlton Comma.

[Assented to 18th December, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Carlton Comma ^{Short title} (Pension and Gratuity) Act, 1975.

Authority to pay

2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary there shall be paid from the Consolidated Fund to Carlton Comma former Secretary/Librarian of the Public Library of Trinidad, who shall be deemed to have retired therefrom on 12th January, 1967 the date on which he attained the age of sixty years, a gratuity of twenty thousand two hundred and fifty dollars and a reduced pension payable monthly at the rate of four thousand, eight hundred and sixty dollars per annum, with effect from 1st January, 1972.
