Act No. 31 of 1974

AN ACT to amend the Appropriation Act, 1974.

[Assented to 17th October, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, ^{Enactment} by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Variation of ^{Short title} 1974 Appropriation) Act, 1974.

Increase in certain Heads of Expenditure

2. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part I of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1974, are hereby increased by the amounts specified in the second column of the said Part I.

Reduction in certain Heads of Expenditure

3. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1974, are hereby reduced by the amounts specified in the second column of the said Part II.

Sums appropriated in respect of Heads set out in Part II of the Schedule may be utilized Ord. 20—1959

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1959, the sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1974 and unissued at the commencement of this Act, may be utilised for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase of expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the first column of Part I of the Schedule.
