Act No. 32 of 1973

AN ACT for the Incorporation of The Church of Christ in
Trinidad and Tobago.

[Assented to 13th September, 1973]

WHEREAS there has been for many years established in ^{Preamble}
Trinidad and Tobago a religious association known as
"The Church of Christ in Trinidad and Tobago":

And whereas it is expedient that the said association
should be incorporated for the purpose of exercising the
powers hereinafter set forth:

Enactment	BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same as follows:—
Short title	1. This Act may be cited as The Church of Christ in Trinidad and Tobago (Incorporation) Act, 1973.
Incorporation	2. The association known as "The Church of Christ in Trinidad and Tobago" (hereinafter referred to as the Church) shall be and is hereby created a body corporate.
Aims and objects of the Church	3. The aims and objects of the Church are to serve the people of Trinidad and Tobago by <i>inter alia</i> : (a) Expounding to the people of Trinidad and Tobago the message of the Bible and encouraging them to adopt the way of life prescribed therein by Jesus Christ; and (b) Encouraging good citizenship and unity among the people of Trinidad and Tobago through the Christian way of life.
Powers of the Church	4. The Church shall have power:— (a) to acquire by purchase, exchange, gift, bequest, devise or otherwise, all messuages, lands, tenements and hereditaments of any tenure and also all moneys, securities for money, goods or chattels whatsoever, and may hold and enjoy the same; (b) to accept surrenders and reconveyances and to enter into contracts; (c) to sell, demise, grant, convey, mortgage, reconvey, surrender, exchange or otherwise dispose of all or any property from time to time vested in it; and (d) to do all such things as may be appropriate to its aims and objects.
Mode of execution of documents	5. All documents requiring the seal of The Church shall be sealed with the common seal of the Church in the presence of two of the Trustees of the Church and its General Secretary for the time being

in office who shall sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and the same is the lawful seal of the Church.

6. The Church shall at all times have a permanent address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on the Church and such address shall be registered with the Registrar General. All documents to be served on the Church may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to the address so registered.

7. The Church may make rules for the proper conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its duties and any such rules may be varied or revoked or added to by the association.

Rules

8. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of Her Majesty, Her Heirs or Successors, or of any bodies public or corporate or of any other persons, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.

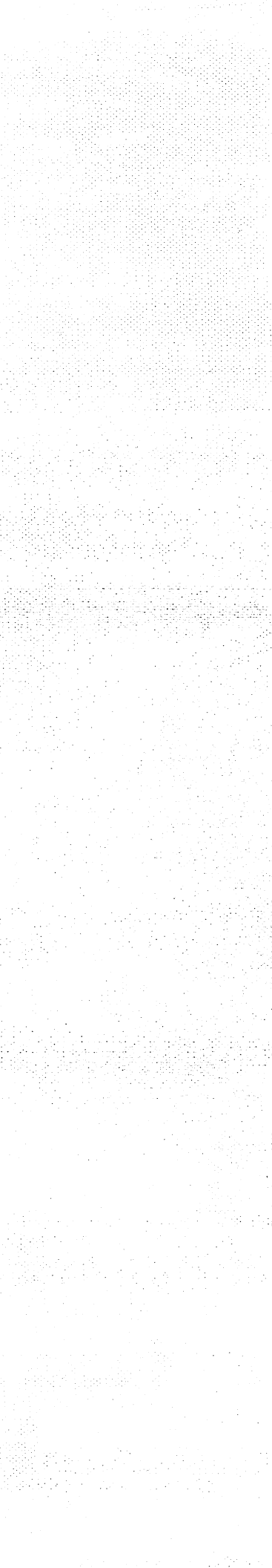
