Act No. 1 of 1974

An Act to provide for the Service of Trinidad and Tobago for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 1974.

[Assented to 30th January, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the authority of the same, as follows;—

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1974, Short title

Issue of \$959,146,694 from Consolidated Fund authorised

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of nine hundred and fifty-nine million, one hundred and forty-six thousand, six hundred and ninety-four dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1974, under the heads of expenditure specified in the Schedule; and the sum specified in the Schedule opposite to a head is hereby appropriated out of the said sum of nine hundred and fifty-nine million, one hundred and forty-six thousand, six hundred and ninety-four dollars for the purposes specified in relation to that head in the Estimates for the said year.
