**Act No. 24 of 1984**

**AN ACT for the Incorporation of the Trinidad Christian  
Center.**

*[Assented to 19th September, 1984]*

WHEREAS since 1980 there has been established in **Preamble**  
Trinidad and Tobago a religious body and community  
service organization known as the Trinidad Christian  
Center:



- (e) to establish and maintain learning institutions such as kindergartens, primary and such other related institutions as the Center is able to provide;
- (f) to provide printing facilities for the use of the Center or the furtherance of the work of the Center;
- (g) to work towards rehabilitating troubled youths and adults, with emphasis on drug related and emotional problems;
- (h) to do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.

5. The assets, rights and franchises now vested in the former Center are hereby transferred to and vested in the Center. Vesting of property

6. All documents requiring the seal of the Center shall be sealed with the common seal of the Center in the presence of the Pastor and Secretary for the time being in office (or in the event of incapacity, by some other person or persons authorised for that purpose by the Center) who both shall sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the Center. Mode of execution of documents

7. (1) The Center shall have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago and such address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the date of incorporation or the change of address, as the case may be. Service of documents

(2) Every document to be served on the Center may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to the registered address of the Center.

(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Center liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

Power to  
make rules

8. The Center may make rules and regulations for the proper conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its duties, powers and functions and any such rules may be varied, revoked or added to from time to time.

Saving of State or  
other rights

9. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State, or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any persons, except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them.
