REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

**Act No. 13 of 1981**

AN ACT for the Incorporation of the "Trinidad and Tobago Amateur Radio Society" and for matters incidental thereto.

*[Assented to 12th June, 1981]*

WHEREAS there has been established in Trinidad and Tobago an organization known as the Trinidad and Tobago Amateur Radio Society. Preamble

And whereas it is expedient that the said organization should be incorporated for the purpose of exercising the power hereinafter set forth:

ment ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:

title 1. This Act may be cited as the Trinidad and Tobago Amateur Radio Society (Incorporation) Act, 1981.

e Society 2. The Trinidad and Tobago Amateur Radio Society (hereinafter referred to as "the Society") is hereby created a body corporate.

e Society 3. The aims and objects of the Society are to provide, foster and encourage interest and participation in Amateur Radio in Trinidad and Tobago.

erty 4. All real or personal property of whatever nature now held by or vested in any person for use and benefit of the Society, is hereby transferred to and vested in the Society.

e of execution  
ocuments 5. All documents requiring the seal of the said society shall be sealed with the common seal in the presence of the President and Secretary for the time being in office (or in the event of incapacity, by some other person or persons authorised for that purpose by the society) who shall both sign every such document and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that the same is the lawful seal of the society.

Society 6. (1) The Society shall at all times have a fixed address for the service of documents on the society and that address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General within twenty-eight days of the date of incorporation or the change of address as the case may be.

(2) Every document to be served on the Society may be served by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to, the registered address of the Society.

(3) Failure to register the address and any change thereof is a summary offence and renders the Society liable to a fine of one hundred and twenty dollars and to a further fine of ten dollars for each day during which the offence continues after conviction therefor.

7. The Society may from time to time make rules and regulations for the proper conduct of its proceedings and discharge of its duties, powers and functions with power to vary or revoke such rules and regulations. <sup>Power to make rules</sup>

8. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons except such as are mentioned in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them. <sup>Savings of State or other rights</sup>
