AN ACT to vary the sums appropriated to Heads of
Expenditure set out in the Appropriation Act, 1982.

[Assented to 25th August, 1982]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Variation of Short title
Appropriation) Act, 1982.

Construction
of Act No. 1
of 1982

2. In this Act and in any other written law reference to the Appropriation Act, 1982 shall be construed as a reference to that Act as for the time being varied or otherwise amended by any Finance (Variation of Appropriation) Act, passed before this Act or that other written law.

Increase in
Heads of
Expenditure

3. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1982 are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part of the Schedule.

Reduction in
Heads of
Expenditure

4. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1982 are reduced by the amounts set out in the Second Column of that Part of the Schedule.

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, the sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to the Appropriation Act, 1982 and unissued at the commencement of this Act may be utilized for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase of expenditure in respect of the Heads set out in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule.
