AN ACT for the Incorporation of Rich Plain Baptist
Church.

[Assented to 27th August, 1982]

WHEREAS there has been for many years established ^{Preamble}
in Trinidad and Tobago a religious body known as
"Rich Plain Baptist Church" (hereinafter called "The
Church").

And whereas it is expedient that The Church be incorporated for the purpose of exercising the powers hereinafter set forth.

Enactment

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:—

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Rich Plain Baptist Church (Incorporation) Act, 1982.

Incorporation

2. The Church is hereby created a body corporate.

Aims and Objects

3. The aims and objects of The Church are:

- (a) to disseminate, teach and spread the word and works of God;
- (b) to encourage citizens of Trinidad and Tobago to join The Church;
- (c) to interest and promote a spirit of understanding through our religious functions and activities;
- (d) to develop an awareness of the social needs of the community;
- (e) to assist the needy and visit and comfort the ailing;
- (f) to foster and encourage children of the district to attend religious instructions and services;
- (g) to extend compassionate benevolence through the awareness of existing personal infirmities or the result of sudden tragedies;
- (h) to develop and implement plans and programmes for increasing the faith and knowledge of church members; and
- (i) to encourage extension of Christian principles into voluntarily receptive homes of the community.
