Act No. 4 of 1981

AN ACT to vary the sums appropriated to Heads of Expenditure set out in the Appropriation Act, 1981.

[Assented to 24th April, 1981]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance (Variation Short title of Appropriation) (1981) Act, 1981.

Construction of
Act No. 42 of 1980

2. In this Act and in any other written law, a reference to the Appropriation Act, 1981 shall be construed as a reference to that Act as for the time being varied or otherwise amended by any Finance (Variation of Appropriation) Act, passed before this Act or that other written law.

Authorisation of
new Head of
Expenditure

3. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the further sum of seventy-three million, two hundred and eighty-six thousand, and sixty-four dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1981, under the Head of Expenditure specified in Part I of the Schedule; and the sum specified in Part I of the Schedule opposite to the Head is hereby appropriated out of the said seventy-three million, two hundred and eighty-six thousand, and sixty-four dollars for the purpose specified in relation to that Head in the Estimates for the said year.

Reduction in
certain Heads
of Expenditure

4. The sums appropriated to the several Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1981 are hereby reduced by the amounts set out in the Second Column of the said Part II.

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Ordinance, 1959, the sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule by the Appropriation Act, 1981 and unissued at the commencement of this Act may be utilized for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase of the expenditure in respect of the Head set out in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule.
