REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

Act No. 29 of 1978

[L.S.]

AN ACT to provide for the Incorporation of a body to be known as the Incorporated Trustees of the Association of Evangelical Bible Churches of Trinidad and Tobago.

[Assented to 4th August, 1978]

WHEREAS there has been established in Trinidad and Tobago a religious association known as the Association of Evangelical Bible Churches of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (hereinafter called "the said Church"), **Preamble**

And whereas the said Church was on the 21st day of January, 1976 incorporated under the Companies Ordinance, Ch. 31. No. 1 as a Company limited by guarantee.

And whereas by a Resolution of the Board of Directors of the said Church, Joseph Catterson, Clarence Elliot, Gerald Joseph, Joseph Catterson Jnr., Prakash Bachew, Carroll Connor and Fitzgerald Yearwood were appointed Trustees of the said Church.

And whereas by a Resolution of the said Church it was resolved that the said Trustees be incorporated under the name "The Incorporated Trustees of the Association of Evangelical Bible Churches of Trinidad and Tobago" with power to hold lands and other property in trust for the said Church.

And whereas it is expedient that the said Trustees should be incorporated.

Enactment

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Incorporated Trustees of the Association of Evangelical Bible Churches of Trinidad and Tobago Act, 1978.

Incorporation of Trustees

2. Joseph Catterson, Clarence Elliott, Gerald Joseph, Joseph Catterson Jnr., Prakash Bachew, Carroll Connor and Fitzgerald Yearwood and their successors in office as Trustees of the said Church shall be, and are hereby created a body corporate by the name of "The Incorporated Trustees of the Association of Evangelical Bible Churches of Trinidad and Tobago".

Trustees may acquire property

3. Subject to the rules, regulations and control of the said Church Incorporated Trustees shall have full power to acquire for the said Church by gift, grant, purchase, demise or otherwise any lands, buildings, messuages and hereditaments of what nature or kind so ever in perpetuity or for life or lives or for a term of years and also any moneys, goods and chattels and subject to such rules, regulations and control as aforesaid and to the performance of any trusts upon which the said lands, buildings, messuages, hereditaments, moneys, goods and chattels may have been acquired, to take hold and enjoy the same.

4. Subject to the rules, regulations and control as aforesaid, and to the performance of any such trusts as aforesaid, and except as hereinafter provided, the Incorporated Trustees may sell, demise, grant, convey, transfer, alienate or otherwise dispose of any property vested in them or which may hereafter be acquired by or become vested in them. Trustees may dispose of property

5. (1) The Incorporated Trustees shall at all times have a fixed address in Trinidad and Tobago for the service of documents on the Incorporated Trustees and such address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General. Service of documents on the Trustees

(2) Any documents may be served on the Incorporated Trustees by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to, the address as registered under subsection (1).

(3) The Incorporated Trustees shall have and use a Common Seal which may from time to time be changed, but which Common Seal shall only be used in the presence of at least three Trustees. Common Seal

6. Nothing in this Act shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of the State or of any bodies politic or corporate, or of any other persons except such as are mentioned or referred to in this Act and those claiming by, through, from or under them. Saving of State or other rights
