Act No. 26 of 1988

AN ACT to establish the City of San Fernando and to
confer on its Council the powers of the San
Fernando Borough Council

[Assented to 15th November, 1988]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as follows—

Enactment

1. This Act may be cited as the City of San Fernando
Act, 1988 and shall come into operation on such date
as the President may appoint by Proclamation.

Short title and
commencement

Interpretation

2. In this Act—

“Borough” means the Borough of San Fernando as referred to in the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance;

“Ordinance” means the San Fernando Corporation Ordinance.

Borough to be known as City

3. Upon the commencement of this Act the Borough shall be known as the City of San Fernando, the Borough Council referred to under the Ordinance shall be known as the City Council and the burgesses of the Borough of San Fernando shall be known as the citizens of the City of San Fernando.

Reference to Borough

4. A reference in the Ordinance, in any written law or in any instrument or other document to the Borough, the Borough Council and the burgesses shall be construed as a reference to the City of San Fernando, the City Council of San Fernando and the citizens respectively.
