ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Finance Short title
(Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation) Act,
2008.

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of three thousand, four hundred and ninety million, sixteen thousand, nine hundred and ten dollars is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending September 30, 2008 and appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure set out in Part I of the Schedule to this Act.

3. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act, 2008 are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

Reduction in Heads

4. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act, 2008 are reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

5. The sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of the Schedule to this Act by the Appropriation Act, 2008 and not utilized at the commencement of this Act may be utilized, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of the Schedule to this Act.
