ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment
follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Short title
Finance (Supplementation and Variation of Appropriation)
(2003) Act, 2004.

Further issue from
the Consolidated
Fund Schedule I

2. A further issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of four hundred and seventy-four million, six hundred and twenty thousand, three hundred dollars is authorized for meeting expenditure for the service of the financial year ending September 30, 2003 and appropriated in respect of the Head set out in Schedule I.

3. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part I of Schedule II by the Appropriation Act, 2003 are increased by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

4. The sums appropriated to the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of Schedule II by the Appropriation Act, 2003 are reduced by the amounts specified in the Second Column of that Part.

5. The sums appropriated in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in the First Column of Part II of Schedule II to the Appropriation Act, 2003 and not utilized at the commencement of this Act and not exceeding the amounts specified as reduced in the Second Column of Part II of Schedule II may be utilized, notwithstanding anything contained in the Exchequer and Audit Act, for the discharge of any liability incurred by reason of the increase in the Expenditure in respect of the Heads of Expenditure specified in Part I of Schedule II.
