AN ORDINANCE to amend the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, Ch. 29. No. 1.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Births and Deaths Registration Ordinance, as from time to time amended, which Ordinance as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 45 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding, immediately after the words "the Superintendent Registrar" the expression "or, where the register books are kept by a Warden in the capacity of Superintendent Registrar, of any officer authorised in writing by the Warden to issue certified copies of entries in such register books."
