AN ORDINANCE to amend the Port Services (Dues, Charges and Management) Ordinance, 1948

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof. Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port Services (Dues, Charges and Management) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Port Services (Dues, Charges and Management) Ordinance, 1948, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short title No. 32 of 1948

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the definition of King's Wharf and replacing the same by the following:—

“ ‘King's Wharf’ means the deep water wharf known as King's Wharf lying to the South of Wrightson Road, Port-of-Spain and includes any wharf to the West thereof which shall be known as King's Wharf Extension.”

Retroactive

3. This Ordinance shall have retroactive effect as from the 9th August, 1952.
