AN ORDINANCE to amend the Police Ordinance,
Ch. 11. No. 1.

Commencement

[25th March, 1954.]

Enactment

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

Ch. 11. No. 1

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Police Ordinance, in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 48 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

- (a) by being renumbered 48 (1);
- (b) by the addition of the following subsection:—

“(2) In the event of any member of the Force leaving the Force without being eligible for a pension or gratuity under the provisions of this Ordinance, whether by reason of dismissal or otherwise, he shall be entitled to the return in full of all deductions made from his pay under subsection (1) of this section; but it shall be lawful for the Governor to direct that any amount due to the Crown in respect of any liability or defalcation be deducted from any amount so returnable.”

Passed in Council this twenty-sixth day of February, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four.
