AN ORDINANCE to amend the Nurses Registration
Ordinance, Ch. 12. No. 19.

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Nurses Registration Short title
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as one with
the Nurses Registration Ordinance, in this Ordinance referred Ch. 12. No. 19
to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by—

- (a) inserting in subsection (1) thereof immediately after the words "paying such fee" appearing therein the words "not being greater than the fee payable on ordinary applications for registration under this Ordinance";
- (b) inserting in subsection (2) thereof immediately after the words "on payment of such fee" appearing therein the words "not being greater than the fee payable on ordinary applications for admission to such final examination."

3. Section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for paragraph (a) of subsection (1) thereof the following:—

- (a) not being a person duly registered under this Ordinance takes or uses the name or title of registered nurse or registered nursing practitioner, either alone or in combination with any other words or letters, or any name, title, addition, description, uniform or badge, implying that she is registered under this Ordinance, or is recognised by law as a registered nurse; or"

4. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the word "should" appearing in the third line thereof the word "shall".

5. The Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph immediately after paragraph 6 thereof:—

"6A. If any member of the Council is prevented by illness, temporary absence from the Colony or any other cause from performing the duties of his office as such member—

- (a) if such member was appointed by the Governor in Council or by the Medical Board of Trinidad and Tobago under paragraph 4 of this Schedule, the Governor in Council or the said Medical Board, as the case may be, may appoint a person to act in the place of such member until such member is again able to perform the duties of his office or ceases to be a member of the Council, whichever is the earlier;

(b) if such member was elected in accordance with the scheme referred to in paragraph 4 of this Schedule, the Council may appoint a person to act in the place of such member until such member is again able to perform the duties of his office or ceases to be a member of the Council, whichever is the earlier :—

Provided that in appointing a person under this sub-paragraph the Council shall, so far as practicable, select a person, being a person registered as a nurse under this Ordinance who is representative of the same interests as those represented by such member”.
