AN ORDINANCE to amend the Hotels (Development Encouragement) Ordinance, Ch. 32. No. 15.

Commencement

[10th June, 1954]

Enactment

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title and construction

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Hotels (Development Encouragement) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Hotels (Development Encouragement) Ordinance, in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The Principal Ordinance, as amended by the Hotels (Development Encouragement) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952-1953, shall remain in force until the 31st day of December, 1959.
