AN ORDINANCE to amend the Wild Animals and Birds
(Protection) Ordinance, Ch. 25. No. 7.

[29th April, 1954.]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wild Animals and Birds (Protection) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Wild Animals and Birds (Protection) Ordinance, in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Short title and construction

Section 22 of

2. Section 22 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for all the words from "who shall establish" to the end of the said section the words "who shall place the same to the credit of the general revenue of the Colony".

Section 24 (h)
of Principal
Ordinance
amended

3. Section 24 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words "and the application thereto of monies standing to the credit of the Wild Birds Fund" appearing in paragraph (h) thereof.

Wild Birds
Fund abolished

4. The Wild Birds Fund established under section 22 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby abolished and any monies which may be standing to the credit of such Fund on the coming into operation of this Ordinance shall be placed to the credit of the general revenue of the Colony.

Passed in Council this second day of April in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-four.
