AN ORDINANCE to amend the San Fernando Electric Works Ordinance, Ch. 39. No. 9.

[1st May, 1954.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the Enactment advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the San Fernando Short title, construction and commencement Electric Works (Amendment) Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read as one with the San Fernando Electric Works Ordinance, in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of May, 1954.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after the definition of "telegraphic line" the following new definition :—

"the Commission" means the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission established under the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission Ordinance;"

3. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by deleting the words "generate and" appearing in the third line thereof; and

(b) by substituting a semi-colon for the full stop at the end of the said section; and

(c) by adding immediately after paragraph (b) of the proviso thereto the following new paragraphs :—

"(c) the Council shall not have the right to generate energy;

(d) the Council shall obtain all energy required for any of the purposes of this Ordinance from the Commission;

(e) where the Governor in Council is satisfied that the Commission cannot provide the Council with a reasonable supply of energy on reasonable terms he may authorise the Council to obtain a supply of energy from such sources as they may think fit or grant a licence to the Council under the provisions of Part VII of the Trinidad and Tobago Electricity Commission Ordinance."

4. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 4 thereof the following new section to be numbered 4A :—

"Council to
have access
to premises of
Commission

4A. The Council shall, by their servants or agents, have access at all reasonable times to the premises of the Commission for the purpose of testing their equipment on such premises with a view to ensuring a constant and sufficient supply of energy to the Council."
