AN ORDINANCE to amend the Oil Rights (Alien Control)
Ordinance, Ch. 21. No. 2.

[31st December, 1954.]

Commencement

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Oil Rights (Alien
Control) (Amendment), Ordinance, 1954, and shall be read
as one with the Oil Rights (Alien Control) Ordinance, herein-
after referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Section 3 (3)

2. Subsection (3) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word "same" appearing at the end thereof the following :—

"or under a licence granted under the Submarine (Oil Mining) Regulations, or any regulations amending or replacing the same".

3. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by deleting paragraph (b) of subsection (4) thereof;

(b) by deleting the words "and every cancellation or variation of a condition" appearing in subsection (5) thereof; and

(c) by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (9) :—

"(9) A licence under this section to hold oil rights may be issued in respect of more than one parcel of land."

Section 6 of
Principal
Ordinance

4. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by deleting paragraph (b) of subsection (3) thereof;

(b) by deleting the words "and every cancellation or variation of a condition" appearing in subsection (4) thereof; and

(c) by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (8) :—

"(8) A licence under this section to hold specified surface rights may be issued in respect of more than one parcel of land."

Section 11 of
Principal
Ordinance
amended

5. Section 11 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by re-numbering the same as 11 (1); and

(b) by adding thereto the following new subsection to be numbered (2) :—

"(2) Regulations fixing fees in respect of licences issued under this Ordinance may fix a scale of fees to be charged according to the acreage of land to which the licence relates."
