AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of a reduced pension and gratuity to Florence Kernahan, formerly Principal of the Roman Catholic Women's Training College.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Florence Kernahan (*Gratuity and Reduced Pension*) Ordinance, 1951.

Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there may be paid from general revenue to Florence Kernahan, formerly Principal of the Roman Catholic Women's Training College, in respect of her services as such Principal, a gratuity of two thousand five hundred and thirty-three dollars and thirty-three cents and a pension, as from the 1st January, 1950, at the rate of seven hundred and sixty dollars per annum.

Passed in Council this twelfth day of January, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one.
