AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of a reduced pension and gratuity to Edwin Young, formerly employed as a Fitter in the Railway Department.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Edwin Young (Gratuity and Reduced Pension) Ordinance, 1951.

Authority to  
pay gratuity of  
\$1,026 and  
annual pension  
of \$307.80 to  
Edwin Young.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there may be paid from general revenue to Edwin Young, formerly employed as a Fitter in the Railway Department, in respect of his services as such Fitter, a gratuity of one thousand and twenty-six dollars and a pension, as from the 4th June, 1950, at the rate of three hundred and seven dollars and eighty cents per annum.
