AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the grant of a reduced pension and gratuity to Benjamin Semper formerly employed as a platelayer in the Railway Department.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Benjamin Semper (Gratuity and Reduced Pension) Ordinance, 1951.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there may be paid from general revenue to Benjamin Semper formerly employed as a platelayer in the Railway Department, in respect of his services as such platelayer, a gratuity of five hundred and eleven dollars and fifty cents and a pension as from the 14th December, 1949, at the rate of one hundred and fifty-three dollars and forty-five cents per annum.
