AN ORDINANCE to continue in force for a further period of twelve months the Hotels (Development Encouragement) Ordinance, 1946.

WHEREAS by section 1 of the Hotels (Development Encouragement) Ordinance, 1946, it is provided that the said Ordinance shall remain in force for a period of five years from the commencement thereof :

And Whereas it is deemed expedient that the provisions of the said Ordinance shall be continued in force for a further period of twelve months from the date on which the Ordinance is due to expire :

Enactment. Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Hotels (Development Encouragement) (Continuance) Ordinance, 1951*.

Ordinance No. 36 of 1946 continued in force until 12th June, 1952 2. The *Hotels (Development Encouragement) Ordinance* is hereby continued in force until the twelfth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.
