AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for computing the pensions of certain employees on their retirement from the Service of Government.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Certain Employees) Ordinance, 1951.

Short title.

2. For the purpose of computing the pensions of the employees whose names appear in the first column of the Schedule hereto on their retirement from the service of Government the period of service appearing in the second column of the said Schedule opposite the name of each employee shall be deemed to be a portion of the unbroken service of such employee.

SCHEDULE

Joseph Cupid	1st December, 1924 to 31st October, 1941
