ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Police (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Police Ordinance, 1950, as amended by the Police (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951.

2. Section 2 of the Police (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, is hereby amended by substituting the expression "who was serving in the Force on the 31st August, 1951, as an Inspector, subordinate police officer, or constable, and" for the expression "serving in the Force at the date of the commencement of this Ordinance as an Inspector, subordinate police officer, or constable".

3. Section 3 of the Police (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, is hereby amended by adding the words "or has retired" immediately after the word "retires".
