AN ORDINANCE to make provision for the charging, levying and collection of oil impost for the twelve months ended 31st of December, 1956.

[1st January, 1958.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Petroleum Department and Conservation Board (Oil Impost for 1956) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Petroleum Department and Conservation Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in sections 7 and 9 of the Principal Ordinance, the oil impost in respect of oil won and footage drilled for oil during the twelve months ended the 31st of December, 1956, shall be at the rate of .1474 of a cent for each barrel of oil won and at the rate of one-half of a cent for each foot drilled for oil.

(2) The oil impost referred to in subsection (1) of this section shall be payable into the Treasury on or before the 31st of January, 1958.
