(Elections) Ordinance, Ch. 2, No. 2.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the Enactment.
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Legislative Council Short title.
(Elections) (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be
read as one with the Legislative Council (Elections) Ordinance, Ch. 2, No. 2,
hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. The First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting Form No. 39 and by substituting therefor the following Form :—

(Section 41).

“FORM No. 39

THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (ELECTIONS) ORDINANCE

OATH OF QUALIFICATION

YOU SWEAR :—

1. That you are a British subject of/above the age of twenty-one years.

2. That you have resided in the Colony for a period of at least one year immediately before the qualifying date.

3. That you are domiciled in the Colony and were resident therein at the date of the commencement of the enumeration.

4. That you have resided in the electoral district of
for a period of at least six months immediately before the qualifying date.

5. That the electoral district in which you have last resided for a period of at least six months is the electoral district of

6. That you were resident in the electoral district of
at the date of the commencement of the enumeration and would have resided for a period of six months immediately before the qualifying date in the said electoral district had you continued to reside in the said district up to the qualifying date.

7. That you are not within any of the classes of persons who lack qualifications or are disqualified by reason of crime, mental incapacity or by any law in force in the Colony relating to offences in connection with elections.

SO HELP YOU GOD.

NOTE—Paragraph 3 is alternative to paragraph 2.

Paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 are alternative to each other.”

3. Paragraph (1) of rule 7 of the Fifth Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting sub-paragraph (a) thereof and substituting therefor the following sub-paragraph :—

“(a) mark the ballot paper by making in pencil or in ink a mark in the form of a cross within the space containing the name of the candidate for whom he intends to vote;”.
