AN ORDINANCE to provide that certain offices shall not be offices of emolument under the Crown for all or any of the purposes of the Trinidad and Tobago (Constitution) Order in Council, 1950.

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (a) of subsection (4) of section 1 of the Trinidad and Tobago (Constitution) Order in Council, 1950, that if it shall be declared by any law in force in the Colony that an office shall not be an office of emolument

under the Crown for all or any of the purposes of the said Order, the said Order shall have effect accordingly as if such law were enacted therein :

And Whereas it is expedient that certain offices shall be declared not to be offices of emolument for all or any of the purposes of the said Order :

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Enactment.

Short title.

Certain offices not to be offices of emolument under the Crown for certain purposes.

Amendment of Schedule.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Legislative Council (Removal of Certain Disqualifications) Ordinance, 1957.

2. The offices set out in the Second Column of the Schedule hereto (being offices constituted under the provisions of law respectively set out in the First Column of the said Schedule), other than any office expressed in the said Second Column to be excluded, shall not be offices of emolument under the Crown for all or any of the purposes of the Trinidad and Tobago (Constitution) Order in Council, 1950.

3. (1) The Governor in Council may from time to time by order amend the Schedule hereto by deleting the reference to any office mentioned therein or by including other offices therein or otherwise as he may consider expedient.

(2) No such order shall have effect unless it has been approved by resolution of the Legislative Council.
