AN ORDINANCE to provide for the incorporation of a body to be known as the Incorporated Trustees of the Fundamental Baptist Mission of Trinidad.

[28th June, 1958.]

WHEREAS a representative body of the Members of the Fundamental Baptist Mission in this Colony, hereinafter called the Church Council, has been constituted, consisting of a chairman, being for the time being the local Superintendent of the Mission in the Caribbean or in his absence his nominee, and representatives of the various churches of the Fundamental Baptist Mission in the area :

Preamble.

And Whereas the Reverend Paul Clement Quamina by virtue of his office of Superintendent in the area and Richard Emanuel Philip and Ena Matilda Quamina, both of the City of Port-of-Spain have been appointed Trustees of the Fundamental Baptist Mission in the area by the said Church Council:

And Whereas the said Trustees so appointed have been requested and they have agreed to accept the office as such Trustees to represent the said Fundamental Baptist Mission in the area and to hold property for any of the uses or purposes of the said Mission in the area:

And Whereas it is expedient that the Trustees for the time being of the said Fundamental Baptist Mission should be incorporated and should have powers to hold lands and other property in trust for the said Mission:

Enactment.

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as The Fundamental Baptist Mission Incorporation Ordinance, 1958.

Incorporation
of Trustees.

2. The Reverend Paul Clement Quamina and his successors in office as Superintendent of the Fundamental Baptist Mission in the Islands of Trinidad and Tobago, and Richard Emanuel Philip and Ena Matilda Quamina and their successors in office as Trustees of the Fundamental Baptist Mission in the said Islands shall be and are hereby created a body corporate by the name of "The Incorporated Trustees of the Fundamental Baptist Mission in Trinidad and Tobago" (hereinafter called "the Trustees") and by that name shall have perpetual succession and also by that name may sue and be sued and shall have a common seal with power to change such seal.

3. The Bethel Baptist Church, at No. 4, Kelly-Kenny Street and all churches, chapels, mission houses, rectories, vicarages, parsonages, glebes, buildings and lands now vested in the Reverend Paul Clement Quamina and appropriated to the uses of the Fundamental Baptist Mission in Trinidad and Tobago are hereby transferred to and vested in the Trustees.

Trustees may
acquire

4. Subject to the rules, regulations and control of the Church Council in the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago, the Trustees shall have full power to acquire for the Fundamental Baptist

Mission in the Colony by gift, grant, purchase, devise or otherwise any lands, buildings, messuages and hereditaments of what nature or kind soever in perpetuity or for a life or lives or for a term of years, and also any moneys, goods and chattels, and subject to such rules regulations and control aforesaid, and to the performance of any trusts upon which the said lands, buildings, messuages, hereditaments, moneys, goods and chattels may have been acquired, to take, hold and enjoy the same.

5. Subject to the rules, regulations and control aforesaid and to the performance of any such trusts as aforesaid, and except as hereinafter provided, the Trustees may sell, demise, grant, convey, transfer, alienate or otherwise dispose of any property by this Ordinance vested in them, or which may hereafter be acquired by or become vested in them.

Trustees may dispose of property.

6. All documents requiring the seal of the Trustees shall be sealed with the Common seal of the Trustees in the presence of two of the Trustees who shall sign every such document, and such signing shall be *prima facie* evidence that the said seal was duly affixed and that it is the lawful seal of the Trustees.

Mode of Execution of Documents.

7. (1) The Trustees shall at all times have a fixed address for the service of documents on the Trustees and such address and any change thereof shall be registered with the Registrar General.

Service of documents on the Trustees.

(2) Any document may be served on the Trustees by leaving the same at, or by sending the same by registered post to, the address as registered under subsection (1) of this section.

8. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect or be deemed to affect the rights of Her Majesty, Her Heirs and successors or of any bodies politic or corporate or of any other persons, except such as are mentioned in this Ordinance and those claiming by, from, or under them.

Saving of Crown and other rights.

Passed in Council this eleventh day of April, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight.
