AN ORDINANCE to amend the Immigration (Restriction) Ordinance, Ch. 20. No. 2.

[27th March, 1958.]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Immigration (Restriction) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Immigration (Restriction) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the definition "immigration officer" the following:—

" "immigration officer" includes the Chief Immigration Officer and the Assistant Chief Immigration Officer."

Section 3 of
Principal
Ordinance
amended.

3. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—
(a) by substituting for paragraph (a) of subsection (1) thereof the following:—

"(1) (a) The Governor shall from time to time appoint a Chief Immigration Officer and an Assistant Chief Immigration Officer for the purposes of this Ordinance."

(b) by repealing paragraph (b) of subsection (1) thereof;
and

(c) by repealing subsection (2) thereof.
