AN ORDINANCE to amend the County Councils Ordinance,
Ch. 39. No. 15.

[On Proclamation]

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the County Councils
(Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1959, and shall be read as one
with the County Councils Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as
the Principal Ordinance.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Governor by proclamation published in the *Royal Gazette*.

Section 99
of Principal

2. Subsection (3) of section 99 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by deleting paragraph (c) thereof;

(b) by relettering paragraphs (d), (e), (f) and (g) thereof as paragraphs (c), (d), (e) and (f) respectively.

New section
99A inserted
in Principal
Ordinance.

3. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 99 thereof the following new section to be numbered 99A:—

“Governor in
Council may
prescribe by
regulations
method and
procedure for
obtaining
supplies for
carrying out
functions of
County
Councils.

99A. The Governor in Council may by regulations prescribe the administrative machinery to be employed and the procedure to be followed in the obtaining of goods, materials and services necessary for the carrying out of the functions of a County Council, and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, such regulations may provide for—

- (a) the establishment and operation of a Board to invite, consider and accept or reject tenders for the supply of any such goods, materials or services, and to perform any other matters connected therewith;
- (b) the payment to the Chairman and members of such Board of such remuneration as the Governor in Council may think fit;
- (c) the duties to be performed by the Chief Executive Officer or any officer of a County Council in connection with the activities of such Board, the supply of any such goods, materials or services, or the execution of agreements with persons whose tenders have been accepted by such Board in relation to any such supply;
- (d) prohibiting the entering into of contracts for the supply of any such goods, materials or services with the members of a County Council or of any committee or sub-committee thereof or with any person in

- the employ of a County Council or with such other persons as the Governor in Council may in such regulations specify;
- (e) compliance by the Board with such general directions as the Governor in Council may give;
 - (f) any matter incidental to any of the matters specified in paragraphs (a) to (e) inclusive of this section."
