AN ORDINANCE to make provision for the grant of a gratuity and a reduced pension to Henry Hamilton Morton, former Headteacher in the Education Department of the Territory.

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Enactment.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Henry Hamilton Morton (Special Gratuity and Pension) Ordinance, 1960.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any law relating to the grant of pensions, there shall be paid from the general revenue of the Territory to Mr. Henry Hamilton Morton, a former Headteacher, a gratuity of three thousand two hundred and thirty-seven dollars, and a pension with effect from the 21st day of December, 1952, at the rate of nine hundred and seventy-one dollars and ten cents per annum.
