AN ORDINANCE to amend the Currency Ordinance,  
Ch. 35. No. 2.

**[On Proclamation]** G.N. 151/55 : No. 21 of 1955

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with Enactment.  
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Currency (Amend- Short title and 1.10.55 commencement  
ment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with the  
Currency Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ch. 35. No. 2  
Ordinance.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Governor by proclamation in the *Royal Gazette*.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting for the definition of the expression "currency note" the following—

" "currency note" means any note provided, issued, deemed to have been issued, or reissued under the provisions of this Ordinance;".

3. Subsection (2) of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced as follows—

"(2) Currency Notes of the Government of Jamaica issued from time to time under the provisions of the Currency Notes Law of the Colony of Jamaica and being, at the time of tender, legal tender in Jamaica (hereinafter referred to as "Jamaica notes"), shall be deemed for the purposes of this Ordinance to have been issued under this Ordinance."

4. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting, immediately after the word "under", the following—

"subsection (1) (a) of section 4 of".

5. Subsection (1) of section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting a colon for the full-stop occurring at the end thereof and by inserting immediately thereafter the following proviso—

"Provided that for the purposes of this Ordinance the value of Jamaica notes shall be calculated at the rate of one pound for four dollars and eighty cents."

Passed in Council this twenty-seventh day of May in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five.
