AN ORDINANCE to repeal the Government Currency Notes Ordinance, and to make provision for the winding up of the Note Security Fund established thereunder.

Commencement

WHEREAS by paragraph (3) of Article 2 of the Agreement set out in the First Schedule to the Currency Ordinance, it is contemplated that the Government Currency Notes Ordinance will be repealed in due course :

AND WHEREAS it is now considered expedient to repeal the said Government Currency Notes Ordinance and to make provision for the winding up of the Note Security Fund established thereunder :

Enactment

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Government Currency Notes (Repeal) Ordinance, 1955.

2. The Government Currency Notes Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Transfer of
moneys in and
liability for
claims against,
the Note

3. All moneys standing or accruing to the credit of the Note Security Fund established under the Government Currency Notes Ordinance are hereby transferred to the credit of the general revenue of the Colony; and any disbursement which but for the repeal of the said Ordinance would have been properly made from the said Fund is hereby declared to be payable from the general revenue of the Colony.
