AN ORDINANCE to amend further the Police Ordinance,
Ch. 11. No. 1.

Enactment ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the
advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title and commencement **1.** This Ordinance may be cited as the Police (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Police Ordinance,
as amended, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and shall come into operation on a date to be
fixed by the Governor by Proclamation published in the *Royal Gazette*.

2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows—

- (a) by the renumbering of the section as subsection (1) of section 5; and
- (b) by the insertion therein of the following subsections as subsections (2) and (3) thereof:—

“(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the contrary, women shall be eligible for appointment as members of the Force and, subject to the provisions of subsection (3) of this section and of any order made thereunder, the provisions of this Ordinance and of the regulations shall apply to female police officers.

(3) The Governor in Council may by order provide that any provisions of this Ordinance shall not apply to all or any female police officers. An order made under this subsection shall have no force or effect until it has been approved by resolution of the Legislative Council.”

3. Section 23 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows—

- (a) by the renumbering of the section as subsection (1) of section 23; and
- (b) by the insertion therein of the following subsection as subsection (2) thereof:—

“(2) Regulations made under this section may provide that any of the regulations—

- (a) shall not apply to all or any female police officers; or
- (b) shall apply only to female police officers or to such of them as may be specified.”

Passed in Council this twenty-first day of January, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five.
