AN ORDINANCE to amend the Roads Ordinance,
Ch. 16. No. 1.

[4th May, 1955.]

Commencement

Enactment

ENACTED by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Roads (Amendment) Ordinance, 1955, and shall be read as one with the Roads Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Ch. 16. No. 1

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the definition of "main road" therein the following definition:—

"Minister" means the member of Executive Council for the time being charged with the administration of matters pertaining to Communications and Works;".

3. Section 32 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) in paragraph (b) thereof, by substituting a comma for the semi-colon at the end thereof, and adding the words and semi-colon "to be appointed by the Minister;";

(b) in paragraph (e) thereof, by substituting a colon for the full stop at the end thereof, and adding the following proviso:—

"Provided that where under this paragraph selection is made of the person for the time being the Head of a designated Government Department, it shall be lawful for any officer of such Department at the request of the Head of the Department to attend any meeting in his place."

Passed in Council this twenty-fifth day of February, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five.
